Sept. 25 – Oct. 10, 2009

Back by popular demand. The musical tale spun by imprisoned Miguel de Cervantes as he reveals the saga immortalized in his novel, *Don Quixote*. The winner of the 1965 Tony for Best Musical and Best Score, with book by Dale Wasserman, music by Mitch Leigh, and lyrics by Joe Darion, the show features the songs *What Does He Want of Me?*, *Dulcinea*, and, of course, *The Impossible Dream*.

The Diary of Anne Frank

Nov. 13 – Nov. 28

The story of Anne Frank and her family's attempt to escape from the Nazi's in occupied Amsterdam, as told through the diary the young girl left behind in their attic sanctuary. A timeless play of hope and inspiration, written by Frances Goodrich and Albert Hackett. Winner of the 1956 Tony Award for Best Play and the Pulitzer Prize for Drama.

Broadway In Concert

Jan. 22 – 24, 2010

Another brand-new collection of songs from Broadway of yesterday and today, showcasing NRTG's very talented vocalists. This year's theme: Travel.

Love Letters

Feb. 5 – 13, 2010

A.R. Gurney's immensely popular theater piece, just in time for Valentine's Day. A profound bond is revealed through a lifetime of letters between a couple, joined by love, though separated most of their lives.

Children of Eden

Feb. 26 – Mar. 13, 2010

An NRTG premiere! This new musical based on the first nine chapters of the Book of Genesis, from creation through the Garden of Eden and Noah's ark, has been winning over audiences since its 1991 London opening. With book by John Caird and soaring music and lyrics by Stephen Schwartz (of *Godspell* and *Wicked* fame).

Anything Goes

May 7 – 22, 2010

Cole Porter's most famous and best-loved musical, with hilarious book by Guy Bolton and P.G. Wodehouse. A young Wall Streeter stows away on an ocean-liner to prevent the girl he loves from marrying, enlisting the help of Public Enemy Number Thirteen and a night club singer/evangelist to win her over. The production is bursting with songs that have become Porter standards: *It's Delovely*, *You're the Top*, *Friendship*, *I Get a Kick Out of You*, *Let's Misbehave*, and on and on and on.
